

Statement of Faith

Inspiration - We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as verbally and plenary inspired, inerrant in the original writings, and supremely authoritative in all matters of faith and practice. Because the King James Version of the Authorized Text has been time-tested and mightily preserved and used by God, we use only the KJV for worship, teaching, and memorization. See section 1.312. (II Timothy 3:16, 17:1; I Peter 1:20, 21)

God - We believe in one God, eternally existent in the persons of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. (Matthew 3:16, 17; Matthew 28:19; II Corinthians 13:14)

Jesus Christ - We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, and is true God and true man. We believe in the resurrection of the crucified body of our Lord, in His ascension into heaven and in His present life there for us as High Priest and Advocate. (Luke 1:26-35, John 1:1-18; Acts 1:9-11; I Corinthians 15:3, 4; Hebrews 4:14-16; I John 2:1, 2)

Man - We believe that man was created in the image of God, that he sinned and thereby incurred physical death and spiritual death which is eternal separation from God, that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and are totally depraved, and that they must be born again to be accepted of God. (Genesis 1:26, 27; John 3:1-21; Romans 3:9-28; Romans 5:12)

Salvation - We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary Sacrifice. We believe that all who believe in Him are justified because of His shed blood and are saved by grace through faith wholly apart from human merit and works. (Isaiah 53; Romans 5:8, 9; I Corinthians 15:3, 4; Ephesians 2:8-10; Hebrews 9:22)

Security of the Believer - We believe that all who receive the Lord Jesus Christ by faith are born again of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God. We believe that they are indwelt and sealed by the Holy Spirit and so are secured unto the day of redemption. (John 1:12, 13; I Corinthians 6:19, 20; Ephesians 1:13, 14; Ephesians 4:30)

Ordinances of the Church - We believe that for the believer water baptism by immersion is an ordained testimony portraying the believer's union with Christ in His death, burial, and resurrection. We believe that Jesus Christ instituted the Lord's Supper to commemorate His death "till He come." Moreover, we believe that neither water baptism nor the Lord's Supper has any saving merit. (John 1:12, 13; Romans 6:3-5; I Corinthians 11:23-28)

Separation - We believe that the Scriptures clearly teach every believer to live a life of separation unto the Lord from all worldly and sinful practices; to abide in Christ; to walk in the Spirit; and to enjoy victory over the world, the flesh, and the devil. (Romans 12:1, 2; II Corinthians 6:14-7:1; Colossians 3:1-17; I John 2:15-17)

Second Coming - We believe in "that blessed hope," the personal and imminent coming of our Lord in the air for His saints. We believe in the personal, visible, and glorious return of Christ to the earth with His saints. We believe that between these events shall occur the seven years of tribulation, Daniel's seventieth week. (Matthew 24:27-30; I Thessalonians 4:13-18; Titus 2:11-14; Revelation 1:7)

Resurrection - We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust, the everlasting blessedness of the saved, and the everlasting punishment of the lost. (Matthew 25:41-46; John 5:28, 29; II Thessalonians 1:6-9; Revelation 20:4-6, 11-15; Revelation 21:1-8)

Satan - We believe that Satan is a personal being, a fallen angel, the prince of demons, the great enticer and deceiver, the god of this age, and the adversary of Christ and His church. We believe that Satan's destiny is eternal punishment in the Lake of Fire. (Isaiah 14:12-15; II Corinthians 4:3, 4; II Corinthians 11:14, 15; I Peter 5:8; Revelation 12:9-12; Revelation 20:10)

Admissions Policy

Valley Baptist Christian School exists to provide Christian Education for Christian families. We do attempt to be discerning in the area of Christian belief and practice. We define a Christian as a person who by faith has received Jesus Christ as personal Savior. (Ephesians 2:8,9; Romans 10:9,10)

We assume that most parents who wish to enroll their children in a Christian school know the Lord as personal Savior and desire that their children be educated with a Christian world view., Our first priority is to serve Christian families. It is our experience that students who come from homes that do not share our world view chafe under the expectations we have and the philosophy we practice.

Valley Baptist Christian School admits students of any race, color, and national or ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, programs, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school.

Every year, Valley Baptist Christian School works to help some students with learning difficulties. We believe that in an atmosphere of Christian love and concern, many such students make tremendous academic progress. However, we do not have the resources and personnel to be able to help effectively with every learning problem. If the teacher and principal determine that a particular student's needs are greater than our school's ability to help, the school may advise the parents to seek assistance elsewhere.

Admission may be denied to any student who has been previously suspended or expelled from another school or who has had to repeat more than one grade.

New students or returning students who seek to enroll in grades 7 through 12 must show evidence of having trusted Christ as Savior and evidence of a personal desire to attend Valley Baptist Christian School.

Enrollment may be limited by the number of students a classroom may accommodate.

Returning students will be given the first priority in registering for the next year. However, beginning with the end of the school year, registrants for the coming year will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Families transferring their child or children from a private or a Christian school must have settled their financial obligations to that school.

In order to enter kindergarten, a child must turn five years old no later than September 30 of that school year.

To be eligible for graduation, a student must enroll no later than the beginning of the senior year. First-time students enrolling in grades ten, eleven, or twelve must make available to the principal records showing what credits they have earned. The principal will then consider the feasibility of the student's being able to meet the requirements for graduation as a condition for enrollment.

Parents must sign a statement that they are aware of the doctrinal stand of Valley Baptist Christian School and that they give their permission for the school to teach their child according to the school's philosophy and doctrine.

New students will not be accepted for enrollment after the end of the first semester unless the family has just moved to this area.
